



# are my letters/numbers legible?

### basic guidelines

- --contrasting colors
- --visible across the parking lot
- --legible font

No painter's tape numbers.

Car numbers and letters must be legible at speed.

Numbers are to be placed on the side of the car.

If possible, no numbers on windows as they are hard to read.
